APPLICATION FOR SENIOR/GRADUATION PROJECT

The Humane Society of Lebanon County provides volunteer opportunities for students needing to complete a community service project to fulfill graduation requirements. All students who apply to complete their project with the Humane Society must have a parent or guardian's permission before beginning their project. All applicants will be required to sign a waiver and release of liability form prior to starting their project. Completing your project with the Humane Society is a great opportunity to make a real difference in the lives of homeless, stray and abused animals in our community. We aim to provide an enriching experience for the student that will encourage personal growth and a lasting commitment to community service and volunteer work in the community.

IDEAS FOR SERVICE PROJECTS:

Organize a Donation Drive

Organize and coordinate a donation drive for the shelter! A shelter "Wishlist" can be found on our website or a hard copy can be provided to you. For this project, you will be expected to coordinate with a local business, organization, group or your school, to set up a donation bin and then promote the collection drive. Donation drives can be done on a small or large scale. We can help you promote your drive on our website and facebook. After the drive is over, drop off the supplies to the shelter. Students will be required to keep track of their time spent on organizing and executing the project. The student should arrange to meet with one of the Volunteer Coordinators after the project is completed, for a typed letter acknowledging successful completion of the project.

BE A SHELTER AMBASSADOR IN THE COMMUNITY

Help us promote our message and mission in the community! Like us on Facebook, invite your friends to do the same, and share our posts to encourage adoption! Help us promote our events by distributing flyers, posters, and pamphlets around the community and then volunteer at one or more of our fundraising events. Students will be required to keep track of the time they spent organizing and executing the project. The student should arrange to meet with the volunteer coordinator after the project is completed for a typed letter acknowledging successful completion of the project.

****Students may complete one or both of the above projects, in order to fulfill their required hours of community service. A project other than those listed above may be considered but must be approved by the Volunteer Coordinators prior to starting.
